Special Election

The Special Election was held at the Sagaponack School. Joseph Louchheim, Vice President of the trustees called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Mr. Louchheim asked the District Clerk, Jeanette Krempler to read the Qualifications of Voters.

Adeline Neubert was appointed Chairperson of the Election.

Barbara Albright and Patrick Guarino were appointed Inspectors of Election.

John French, Notary of the Public of Suffolk County, asked the chairperson and the two appointed tellers to sign a sworn statement to affirm their duties to the best of their abilities. All parties signed the statement.

The ballots were handed out by the chairperson to 103 registered voters.

Patrick Guarino read the results of the vote at 8:30 p.m..

37 Absentee Ballots were not accepted by the Inspectors of Election due to unsigned ballot envelopes.

The Chairperson and the Inspectors of Election were thanked and dismissed.

A motion was made by Joseph Louchheim and seconded by Fred Wilford to open the meeting @ 9:00 p.m. to adjourn into Executive Session to litigate with counsel. Executive Session was closed @ 9:12 p.m. Passed 2-0.

A motion was made by Joseph Louchheim @ 9:15 p.m. and seconded by Fred Wilford to open the meeting to the public.

A motion was made by Joseph Louchheim to commence an appeal to the NYS Commissioner of Education pursuant to NYS Education Law 2047 to seek an order vitiating and annulling the results of the Special Election held on Tuesday, April 12, 2011 and authorizing the Board of Education to hold a new election due to a discrepancy with the absentee ballots. Fred Wilford seconded the motion. Passed 2-0.

With no further business the meeting was adjourned at 9:40 p.m. by Joseph Louchheim and seconded by Fred Wilford. Passed 2-0.
